Daniel David Donnellon, 48, of Capac, died Saturday morning June 28, 2008 at Mt. Clemens Regional Medical Center, Mt. Clemens after a courageous battle against cancer.

He was born October 30, 1959 in Grosse Pointe the son of Richard and Gwendolyn Rickard Donnellon.

His marriage to Christina Carlson was August 15, 1980 in St. Clair Shores.

Dan was a parishioner of St. Nicholas Catholic Church, Capac. He was employed by Michigan Rivet Company from 1983 until it's closing in 2005.

Dan was a longtime member of the U.A.W. Local # 155 and was plant chairman of M.R.C. He was a Capac Village council member and Mayor Pro-Tem and was currently running for state House of Representatives of St. Clair County. Dan enjoyed hunting, fishing, golfing and back road wild asparagus picking. But most of all, Dan loved spending time with his grandsons.
