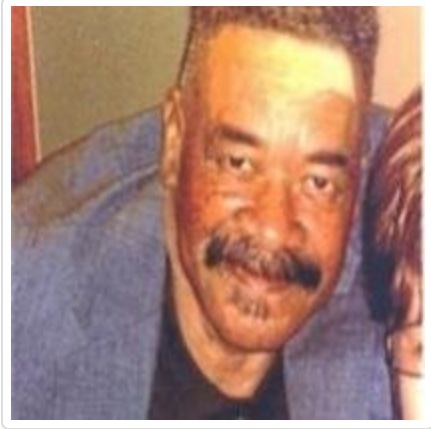




Eugene Elliott

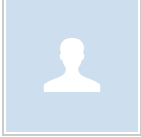
