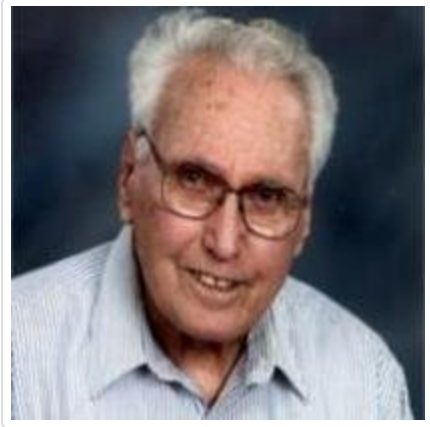




Frank Steve Simon

Frank Steve Simon

96, of Lenox Township, died Sunday November 17, 2013, at New Haven Pines AFC Home.

He was born in Highland Park, January 22, 1917, the son of the late Stephen and Elizabeth (Drach) Simon. He was a graduate of New Haven High School. His marriage to Loretta Dailey was in September 1941, in Illinois. Loretta died in August 1997.

Frank served his country with the United States Army from 1939 to 1945 during World War II.

Frank moved to New Haven in 1936 and worked for Pontiac Motors from 1936 to 1939. He worked for Philco Appliance Company for 16 years and for New Haven Community Schools as a custodian for 35 years before his retirement in 1992.
