George Willard Frampton, 91, of Yale, passed away Tuesday, September 9, 2008 at Country Meadows of Carsonville.

He was born December 7, 1916, the son of the late Willard E. and Goldie M. Harden Frampton.

His marriage to Dorothy Ann Miller took place in 1955 in Flint. Dorothy died in 1987.

George served his country as a civil servant with the United States Department of Defense for 27 years before his retirement in 1980. He served as mayor for the village of Sterling from 1973 to 1976.
