Irene Minnie (Wagner) Schoenberg

89, a lifelong Capac resident, passed away November 16, 2014 at McLaren Lapeer Region Hospital after a brief illness.

Irene was born November 3, 1925 to Alfred and Alma Wagner.

She married Carl Schoenberg on March 17, 1945. Carl passed away in 1973.

Irene and Carl served the Capac community for 22 years as owners and operators of the Standard Oil service station in town from 1949 to 1971. After Carl's death Irene continued serving the community through the Capac Library until 1998 where she worked for 30 years and the Capac Police Department until 1990 where she worked for 19 years.

She was a lifelong member of St. John Lutheran Church where she served her Lord as a Sunday School teacher and a member of the altar society, choir and women's society.

Irene is survived by her son Brian (Glenda) Schoenberg, sister, Donna Wagner, grandson, Jason (Rachel) Schoenberg and two great-grandsons, Michael and Liam Schoenberg and several cousins. In addition to her parents and husband, Irene was preceded in death by her daughter Virginia Schoenberg in 1988 and her brother Sharold (Lefty) Wagner in 2012.
