Jason Oliver Shinn

92, of Fremont Township, passed away Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at United Hospice Residence, Marlette,

He was born in Pellston, October 1, 1922, the son of the late George and Eva (Williams) Shinn and moved to Fremont Township in 1953.

His marriage to Mary Lou Severance was July 2, 1949, in Bellaire. After nearly 54 years of marriage, Mary Lou passed away June 23, 2003. Jason found love again and married Tiena June (Baraboll) Britton on December 23, 2005, at Bethel Missionary Church, Roseburg.

Jason served his country with the United States Navy from 1943 to 1946 during World War II. He traveled abroad on the U.S.S. Wisconsin as a Gunner's mate and mount captain of 5"/38 caliber guns.

Jason was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Yale where he was the Sunday school superintendent. He later attended Roseburg and Brown City Missionary Churches. He was a dairy farmer on his own farm, Brown Rd. Fremont Twp, for over 50 years before his retirement in 2004. He was a member of the Nation Dairy Herd Information Association for 8 years and a M.A.B.C. board member for 8 years. Jason enjoyed traveling in the United States.

Surviving in addition to June, his wife of nearly 9 years are three daughters Vicki Garrett of Florida, Janis Shinn of Mt. Pleasant and Phyllis Shinn of FL., three sons and daughters-in-law Ted and Donna, Bob and Patti and Jeff and

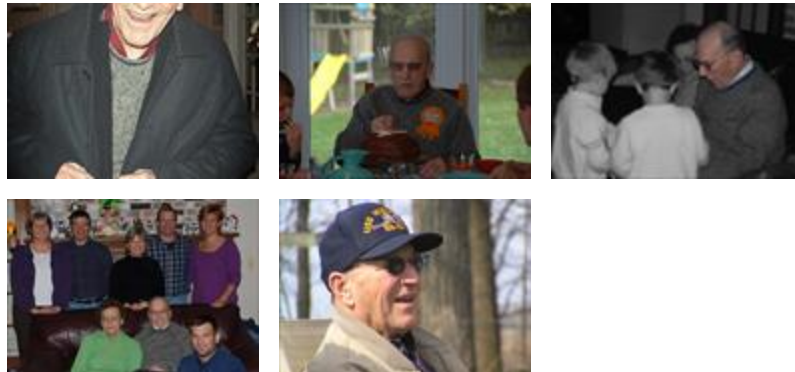

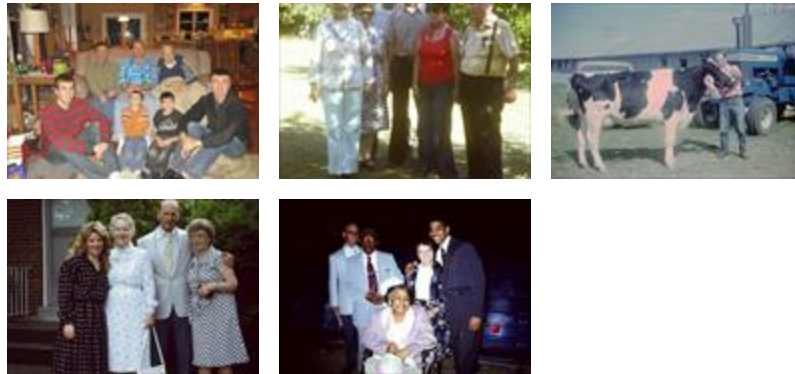
