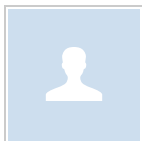

Mrs Kipp was a lovely woman and I remember fondly. My heart goes out to all of you. Accept my apology for not being able to attend today.

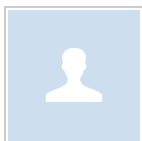
