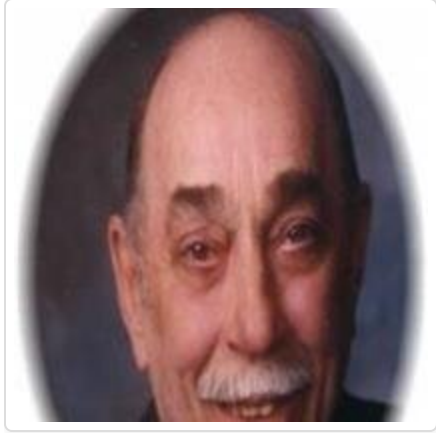




Kenneth Richards
