Lloyd Klause, 92, of Yale, passed away Sunday, October 5, 2008 at Medilodge of Yale.

He was born in Port Huron, November 12, 1915, the son of the late William and Eulalia Mitchell Klause.

His marriage to Betty McGaw was September 15, 1941 in Port Huron. Betty died February 28, 2008 after a long battle with Alzheimer's.

Lloyd served his country with the U.S. Army in Germany during World War II. He worked for Fisher Body in Flint from 1949 until 1966 when he began work at the GM Tech Center in Warren. Lloyd retired in 1975 then moved to Florida with Betty in 1985 where they stayed thru 2007. His wife enjoyed bingo, loved bowling and was a beautiful sewer.
