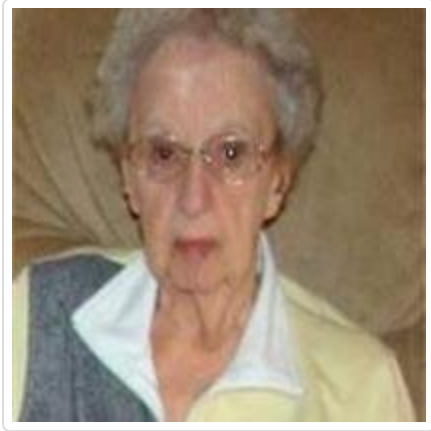




Loretta Rita Colella

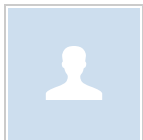

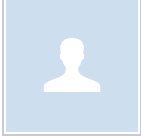
