Mark Stephen King, 60, of Lenox Township, passed away unexpectedly, Saturday, November 12, 2011 at his home.

He was born in Detroit on Monday, June 11, 1951, the son of Rosemary (Libbrecht) King and the late Floyd King.

Mark quit high school to serve his country in Vietnam in the United States Army with the 101st Airborne Division on two tours of duty during the Vietnam Conflict. Mark later received his G.E.D. during his service.

Mark worked for D-Mark, Chesterfield, for many years before his retirement due to health reasons. He was a member of the St. Clair Shore Sportsman Club, Lenox Township, the Walleye Club and a lifetime member of the AMVET Post 72, New Haven. Mark enjoyed hunting and fishing.

Surviving are his mother, Rosemary King of Memphis; a brother, Jody King of Memphis; two sisters and a brother-in-law, Kathleen King of Memphis and Sharon Herrera of Monroe, as well as 2 nephews and friends.

He was preceded in death by his father, Floyd King (1997) and brother-in-law, Julian Herrera (2006).
