Peter DeMiglio

84, of Memphis, passed away after a brief illness Monday, May 26, 2014 at St. Joseph Mercy Port Huron Hospital.

He was born in Jersey City, New Jersey, August 6, 1929, the son of the late Antonio and Julia (Elia) DeMiglio.

His marriage to June Ann Seifert was October 10, 1959, at All Saints Catholic Church, Memphis. June died June 4, 1999.

Peter served his country from 1947 to 1950 with the United States Army as a tank gunner during the Korean War.

Peter was a parishioner of Holy Family Parish, Memphis, and a prior member of the Knights of Columbus and James Coleman VFW Post #6802, Richmond.

Peter served his apprenticeship with the Pennsylvania Rail Road which lasted 3 years. Peter sang and played the bass guitar with his band "The Tunesters".

They traveled across the country for 20 years performing in every state except Hawaii. He sang for weddings and continued singing for the Holy Family

Parish Church parishioners. He was a master salesman for 10 years in the

early 1970's for Fruin/Skinner Auto Sales, Richmond and had worked for

Semco Energy in Marketing for 10 years until his retirement in 1994. Peter
