Robert August “Bob” Enright, Jr., 81, of Richmond, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, January 22, 2009 at home.

He was born Wednesday, November 7, 1928 in Armada, the son of the late Robert and Mamie (Campbell) Enright.

His marriage to Margaret Helen Pratt occurred on September 3, 1949, at Trinity Lutheran Church, Richmond.

Bob served his country with the United States Army during the Korean War from 1952 to 1956, .
