Robert Bruce Adams, 68, of Kenockee Township, died Saturday evening October 10, 2009 at Medilodge of Yale.

He is the son of Edward L. and Lola Renshaw Adams who preceded him in death. He was born in Detroit February 28, 1941.

He served his country with the U. S. Army and was graduate of its paratrooper school at Fort Bennington, Ga.

"Bob" was an ironworker for 25 years and member of Ironworkers Union Local #25. He had a medical retirement in 1992. He was a ham radio operator and received his Federal Commission Amateur Radio license in December of 2002 and was active with the "Prop Buster" a radio controlled airplane club. Bob and Carol Taylor Burleigh were married in Oak Park February 11, 1972. They have lived in Mt. Clemens many years, moved to Memphis in 1981 and built their home in Kenockee Township in 2001.
