



## Rosina Katherine Schmidt

October 27, 1931 - March 2, 2014

Rosina Katherine Schmidt, 82, of Richmond, passed away Sunday, March 2, 2014, at McLaren Macomb Hospital, Mt. Clemens.

She was born in Yugoslavia, October 27, 1931, the daughter of the late John and Rosalia (Pertschy) Dorner and grew up on the family farm in Union City. She and Richard L. Schmidt were married in Detroit on May 9, 1953, and had lived in Roseville until she moved to Richmond in 2002. Richard died October 9, 2009.

Rosina was a parishioner of St. Augustine Catholic Church, Richmond and had worked for Sears for 35 years in the credit bureau and cash office until her retirement in 2007 at the age of 75.

She enjoyed visiting northern Michigan and Las Vegas casinos, knitting, crocheting, cards and loved spending time with her friends and especially her family.

Surviving are two daughters and sons-in-law, Rosanne and Charles Osborne of New Baltimore and Randy and Jack Randazzo of IL and son and daughter-in-law, Richard and Deborah of Riley Township; grandchildren, Nicole (Jason), Richard (Tara), Kacey (Matt), Brooke and Krystal and great-grandsons Nolan, Colten and Madden, as well as many friends.
