William Levi Wilson

81, of Fort Gratiot, died Monday, April 13, 2009, at home following a short illness with cancer.

He was born Thursday, May 5, 1927, in Fremont Township the son of the late Frank and Hattie (Donnenworth) Wilson.

His marriage to Elouise (Pud) Molesworth was Saturday, June 26, 1948, at Yale United Methodist Church.
